Dear Neighbors,

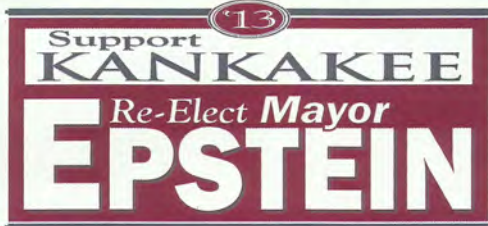
